We currently have an immediate opening for a relief bus driver. This driver will be utilized for school, camp and support with recreation activities during the weekday, and at times, on the weekends.

- Must be a class 2 license driver
- 17 dollars per hour.
- Must be willing to work a flexible and changing schedule of relief hours to begin.
- Position has the potential for part-time to full-time hours down the line (split shifts, morning and afternoon, with some transportation support required on weekends for certain family activities).
- Must be patient, humorous, flexible, positive, love children, and have a passion for working with a disadvantaged population.
- Must have an understanding of poverty, homelessness, addictions and mental illness, and be open minded to the behavioral struggles that may be indirectly affecting the children that you are transporting.
- We are looking for a special individual that has all of the above qualities. Every child that we transport must be treated with fairness, dignity and respect. The successful candidate must be able to multi-task and address challenging behavior (etc. verbal arguments between children, children hitting each other, or children challenging bus rules) with a calm, yet assertive approach. The candidate for this position must be a patient individual!
